### **CONTINUING STUDENTS - FORMS AND INFORMATION UPDATE**

As autumn approaches, it is time to update your child’s records and fill out state required forms. Packets will be put in the children’s Friday Folders on August 18.

Each fall, we ask families to complete a new ID Emergency form to ensure that we have current information for your child. Also, the State checks your child’s immunization records to verify that they are properly immunized. Please bring in a copy of any NEW immunizations your child may have received since beginning their enrollment at Montessori Schools of Irvine. As these immunizations are required by the State for enrollment, children showing deficiencies will need to receive the required dosage in order to continue attending school.

### **TEACHER IN-SERVICE WEEK**

Friday, August 25 is the last day of the regular summer session. The week of August 28-31 (Monday-Thursday) is TEACHER IN-SERVICE WEEK. Montessori classes **will NOT** be in session during this week. Day care for continuing students is available. A good part of our days will be spent outside having the last of the summer fun! Since so much of our time is spent playing outside, please be sure to apply plenty of sunscreen to your child before they come to school, and feel free to have them wear a hat! Lunch and PM snacks will be served by the school. Montessori Schools of Irvine are **CLOSED** Friday, September 1, 2017.

### **SCHOOL HOURS REMINDER!**



Montessori Schools of Irvine open at 7:00 AM for our early childhood – primary programs and **7:30 AM for our infant toddler program**. Please be so kind as to allow our staff to open the school before dropping off your children for safety and security reasons. School closes at 6:00 PM. After 6:00 PM, our late fees are \$1 per minute paid to cover the staff time of those who remain after this time with your child.

### **2017-2018 TUITION RATES**

All of us at the Montessori Schools of Irvine thank you for the privilege of sharing the precious moments of your child's early childhood years with us. We take our partnership very seriously.

Our mission is to provide the highest quality of Montessori early childhood education and care available – *anywhere*. We continue to be an NAEYC accredited school and an American Montessori Society Affiliated Program. Compromising on the quality of your experience is not an option for us. This requires an extraordinary, stable staff of highly qualified professionals as well as an environment that is both beautiful and enriched with a multitude of appropriate materials.

Our tuitions are set annually for the school year which begins September 1 and ends August 31. This year our program has been impacted, just as many others have with increased staff health care costs as well as changes in employment law. Additionally, the

cost of procuring healthy foods in order to provide nutritional fresh lunches and snacks daily also increased our operating costs.

We have budgeted very carefully and will need to increase rates \$50 per month to cover our increased operating costs.

**Tuition Rates for the 2017-2018 School Term – Effective Sept. 1, 2017**

Infants \$1,745.00/mo. (3 mos. – 1 yr./walking)

Toddlers \$1,695.00/mo. (walking to 3 years)

Full Day Preschool \$1,435.00 /mo.

Kindergarten-Primary \$1,475.00/mo.

**MONTESSORI SCHOOLS OF IRVINE GIVE ONE FULL TUITION TO DISCOVERY CUBE (Children’s Science Center) TO HELP STEM EDUCATION!**

Each year Montessori Schools of Irvine allows Discovery Cube to auction a full year of tuition to either a caring already enrolled family or a family who is on our waiting list who will gain immediate entry into the program at the school of their choice. This auction item is **now available for live bidding in time to utilize it for this coming year. All proceeds from this auction item go directly to Discovery Cube!** The value of the tuition for either preschool or Kindergarten/Primary Grades is between \$17,499 - \$17,999.

This is also open to our current parents and as the bid includes the registration fee, we will refund the \$100 registration fee for your continuing child if you “buy it now” for Discovery Cube. The full \$18,000 bid would still be paid to Discovery Cube for scholarships.

Bids will be taken on a first come first serve basis so don’t hesitate if you’re interested to bid at a price you are comfortable with. The “buy it now” auction price is \$18,000.

If still available, live bidding will take place on September 23, 2017 at the Discovery Cube Gala. (Reservations for this Gala can also be made through Lacy White. This year’s theme: “Beyond the Tide!” to highlight the new Newport Beach facility!)

**NEW STUDENTS, “MEET YOUR TEACHER”**

Thursday, August 31 at 8:30 a.m. is “Meet Your Teacher” for all new students. This time is set aside for all **NEW** students (September start date) and their parents to stop by the classrooms to meet their teachers for the first time. Continuing parents who have already met their child’s teacher are not required to attend.

We would like to remind ALL new parents that our entire staff is prepared to assist your child with entering their group of children each morning. Please feel free to go to any staff person in the classroom or on the playground to transfer your child into the school day. Please be sure to let the teacher at hand know that YOU, the parent, are *ready* to relinquish your child for the day. Teachers will not interfere with the separation process if they feel you are not ready to let them help you!

#### Quinoa Salad



#### Ingredients:

##### **For the Quinoa:**

- ½ c. quinoa
- 1 c water or stock

##### **For the Salad:**

- 1 c. shelled edamame
- 1 c. loose corn
- ½ c Diced tomato
- ½ c. chopped fresh cilantro

##### **For the Salad Dressing: (note: bottled dressing can also be used)**

- ¼ c. fresh Lime juice
- 2 t. olive oil
- Salt and pepper to taste

#### Preparation:

1. Prepare Quinoa by simmering in the liquid approximately 15 minutes until water is absorbed then remove from heat and cool
2. Toss quinoa with salad ingredients
3. Combine dressing ingredients to make the dressing
4. Thoroughly mix the dressing and ingredients
5. Chill before serving
