## PARENT/TEACHER CONFERENCES

### DAY CARE ONLY – (Montessori Classes not in session)

During Parent-Teacher conferences, our head teachers are busy speaking with all of you about your children's progress. We realize that many parents work and would be thus impacted if we closed school on these days, however, as our head teachers are otherwise engaged, only child care will be provided. **Regular classes will not be in session!** Children will be spending most of their day outside and all children will have an extended rest time. This is a great "stay home" or "sleep in" day for children whose parents do not need day care.

*Parent-Teacher conferences for preschool, kindergarten and primary are scheduled:*

#### **All Day Conference day - Wednesday, May 16**

Conferences will be scheduled for 20 minute sessions from 9-5:20 PM

#### **Alternate morning Conference times - Friday, May 18**

Conferences will be scheduled for 20 minute sessions from 7-10:40 a.m.

(Kindergarten and Primary conferences will be scheduled from 7-8:40 am ONLY)

**Reminder: MONTESSORI CLASSES WILL NOT BE IN SESSION on Wednesday, May 16 or Friday, May 18. Outside day care activities** have been scheduled for children needing care.

**Registration sign-up sheets will be posted in the FRONT OFFICE on Wednesday, May 2.**

We realize that parents sign up for conference times around their work schedules and need to return to their jobs at specific times. We will try to stay on schedule that day and request that all parents help us by arriving **5 minutes prior** to their scheduled conference as well as respecting the next person's conference time. Parents who do not arrive on time will have a shortened conference session or may miss their conference. On conference day, we ask that you check in at the front desk *before* going to your child's classroom, so as not to disturb a conference in progress. A copy of your child's progress report will be in their Friday folders on Friday, May 11. By taking the time to review the progress report before your conference you can maximize your conference time with your child's teacher.

We encourage ALL parents to participate in parent conferences, as it is the perfect time to sit with the teacher and focus on YOUR CHILD without interruption. Regretfully, with June program preparations upon us, teachers will be unable to provide additional times to review your child's progress report following the formal conference date.

## PARENT QUESTIONNAIRES FOR ACCREDITATION

As parents, we know that you are proud to have your child at an NAEYC accredited program. A VERY important component of our accreditation relies on positive feedback from our parents. We ask you to participate in this process twice each year. PLEASE take a moment at parent conference time to complete the required questionnaire to assist us in maintaining this important status within the community and providing us with your valuable feedback.

We have, through our continued self-study process, been able to meet all the criterion being asked about on this parent questionnaire and thus you should be able to answer a "YES!" to all of the questions that pertain to your child/family. However, if you are hesitant to answer yes, PLEASE take a moment to ask our director how exactly this criterion is met.

We have learned that sometimes parents are unaware of how we rank a yes simply because they have not had the need or opportunity to experience it. Please do not leave an answer blank as this lowers our percentage of "yes". Some questions only apply to a small group of families, and there is a non-applicable (N/A) to mark. If there is not a non-applicable choice, please answer after finding out how we meet the criterion.
