October is a very busy month! Keep your October Newsletter handy as a reference and remember to watch the front office windows for reminders of upcoming events.



### SCHOOL PICTURE DAY

Reminder: Please save Friday, October 12 for School Picture Day. Images 4 Kids will be taking individual photos of all enrolled children in our school atrium on this day. There is no prepayment necessary. Proofs will be available at the school approximately 2-3 weeks following picture day. You may purchase photo packages at that time.

If your child is absent on picture day, there will be ONE make-up picture day for children from all four schools on Wednesday, October 24 at our Westpark Montessori beginning at 9:00 a.m. and only as long as needed. Parents are responsible for transporting their child to and from Westpark for the make-up picture day.

### UPDATE REMINDER . . .

Please remember to **update** your child's ID EMERGENCY information at the front desk. Updated information includes if you have moved, changed jobs, or changed **any** phone numbers or people with permission to pick up your child. Please remember to also update your child's immunization record if they have received any new vaccinations or health information. Thank you.

### PUMPKIN PATCH FIELD TRIP

A BIG thank you to all of the parents who have brought in their immunizations to the school Director. Due to your quick response, we did not have to cancel this trip and it has allowed those parents to chaperone this field trip!

Again, this fall we will be traveling to Tanaka Farms Pumpkin Patch and vegetable gardens, located in Irvine. The Tanaka Farms Pumpkin Patch allows children to pick their own pumpkins right off the vines. The field trip also includes a wagon ride, petting zoo and a corn maze! The field trip to Tanaka Farms will take place on Friday, October 19. The cost of the trip is \$21.00 for children and the entrance fee for parent chaperones is \$7.00 (The chaperone fee does NOT include a pumpkin.)

Permission slips will be available starting Friday, September 28<sup>th</sup> at the front desk. Preschool children under 4 must have a parent chaperone (and that parent must have already submitted their proof of immunizations)! The trip will close once the bus is full. **All children attending must wear a Montessori rainbow t-shirt!** Tennis shoes or closed toed shoes are a must, as it makes walking in the pumpkin patch field easier to navigate.

**Parent chaperone reminder:** All chaperones must have a current immunization record on file at the school. Please bring a back pack and wear “comfy” shoes for walking in the pumpkin patch. As always, we ask that you turn off your cell phones while chaperoning on this trip. Thank you.

### ANNUAL HALLOWEEN PARTY AND PARADE

Our annual Halloween party and parade has been scheduled for **Wednesday, October 31 at 3:30 p.m.** Children should come to school with their **school clothes on** and their costume in a **PAPER bag**. The bag and **ALL parts of the costume must be labeled** with your child’s name. Please be aware that regretfully, sometimes even with labeling, mix-ups can occur! Children will be dressed in their costumes following their afternoon snack.

**Please, NO MASKS! Masks frighten many young children.**

Parents are welcome to join us for the parade which takes place at the front of the school. The parking lot (and drop off area) will be blocked off from 2:30 – 4:30. The preschool and kindergarten children will be parading along the front sidewalk of the school. They will come out of the school (close to the Salvation Army Bin) and will exit through the toddler gate to return to their classrooms. They will stop briefly for a group photo at their labeled spot along the sidewalk, so please place yourself according to those signs for the best possible photo opportunity.

Parents are invited to sign up in the front office to bring in special Halloween goodies on this day and we will also invite two parent volunteers (**Parent volunteer must have immunization record on file with the school**) from each classroom to assist the teachers with costume changing. Sign-ups will be posted in the front office on Wednesday, October 17.



### \*IMPORTANT NOTE REGARDING DISMISSAL ON HALLOWEEN!!

**\*DISMISSAL:** Parents who are taking their children with them after the parade are asked to **PLEASE WAIT OUTSIDE** until the children return to their classroom after the parade and we will dismiss the children after taking attendance to ensure all children are safe. Thank you! This helps us keep all children safe and confusion to a minimum. Once the children are back inside the classroom, **parents are asked to enter the school through the toddler gate and proceed to their child’s classroom through the playground (the glass door) for pick up. You can sign your child out with your child’s teacher and proceed through the front doors to exit the school.**

It has been our experience that most children leave for holiday activities with their parents after the parade thus leaving only one or two children at school feeling confused that their parents did not pick them up. Thus, to support their emotional well-being, we will be closing the school at 5:00. Parents are asked to remember to pick their children up no later than **5:00 P.M. on Halloween.**

**PLEASE NOTE:** If the ghosts and goblins bring rain on this day, the parade will be canceled. If this happens, parents will be invited to take pictures in the classroom from 3:30-4:00.

### **PARENT CONFERENCES AND PROGRESS REPORTS**

Regular Montessori classes will not be in session during this time. Daycare activities will be available.

A copy of your child's progress report will be in your child's Friday folder on Friday, November 9. Please take the time to review this progress report **BEFORE** your scheduled conference time. Feel free to make notes or jot down questions to bring with you to your conference. With your child's progress report, you will receive a parent questionnaire to share your thoughts about your child's school experiences and ensure that the teacher is able to address these during the conference. Please complete this form and return it to the front desk for your child's teacher before conference day. ### **STATE OF CALIFORNIA REGULATIONS AND YOUR CHILD'S BEDDING**

California Department of Social Services/Community Care Licensing requires that ALL children under 2 years (their definition of "infants") have their bedding changed DAILY. The section of the law is below:

*101439.1 INFANT CARE CENTER NAPPING*

*e(1) Bedding shall be changed daily, or more often if required by (e) above.*

After much discussion we have determined that it will be easier for our families with children in our infants and ones rooms if **we** provide crib sheets **for you** and launder them here at the school! (Our current procedure will remain in effect for our twos room.) HOWEVER, it will take a week or two to for us to procure the sheets. Thus, we ask that parents provide 3 sheets for the time being, labeled with your child’s name. We ask for this so we have a day in-between to launder them and one in case of an accident.

As soon as **our** sheets arrive, we will send yours home to keep! Please note: We are unable to do separate loads as we will be washing many sheets daily and, while we intend to use fragrance free baby friendly detergent, we are not able to personalize the process for each child. Thus, if you wish to have your child’s bedding laundered in a specific way, please send 5 appropriately sized fitted sheets to school weekly and we will continue the procedure of sending the sheets home with you each Friday and you returning them laundered on Monday. Thank you for helping us keep Child Care Licensing happy!



**HALLOWEEN PARTY AND PARADE**

Our Halloween parade will be on **Wednesday, October 31 at 3:15 p.m.** The Toddlers and Two’s will parade on our playground (the gazebo side). Please see above for more information on our Halloween parade.

The **parking lot will be blocked off from 2:30-4:30 on Wednesday, October 31**, so if you need to leave during this time, DO NOT park in the lot. Remember, ALL children must be picked up by 5:00 on Halloween.

**EXTRA CLOTHES**

As we breeze into fall please remember to check your child's extra clothes supplies. Each child should always have at least three extra sets of clothes to be kept at school. Each set should include: socks, shirt, and long pants. Extra clothes should be put in a large zip lock baggie and **PLEASE LABEL EACH PIECE OF CLOTHING**. Early mornings are sometimes chilly, so you may want to leave a light coat in your child's bin.

**Spaghetti Dinner Recipe**

3 T olive oil  
1 yellow onion diced  
1 T crushed garlic  
½ c chopped basil  
½ c chopped thyme  
½ c chopped oregano  
1 t cracked black pepper  
1 c marsala wine  
1 pound ground meat, browned and strained  
2- 8 oz. cans of tomato sauce  
1- 8 oz. can tomato juice  
1 T tomato paste  
1 pound pasta noodles, cooked

In a stock pot heat olive oil, add onions and garlic. Add all dry ingredients. Add marsala wine and boil until half of the liquid is reduced. Add beef, tomato sauce, tomato juice and tomato paste. Simmer for 20 minutes. Add sauce to noodles and mix. Cover and heat in the oven at 200° for 15 minutes. (Optional: top with fresh grated parmesan cheese)
