## **PARENT/TEACHER CONFERENCES WEEK DAY CARE ONLY – (Montessori Classes not in session)**

During Parent-Teacher conferences, our head teachers are engaged with our parents rather than our children. We realize that closing the school for a full day of parent conferences would impact our working families. Thus, in order to continue providing appropriate care for the children and maintain our state mandated teacher ratios, classrooms will rotate conference days on Monday -Thursday with one morning session of conferences for all classes on Friday only. On Friday morning, regular Montessori classes will not be in session and only CHILD CARE with mostly outdoor playtime will be provided. This is a great “stay home” or “sleep in” day for children whose parents do not need day care.

Kindergarten/Primary classes: 7 a.m. – 9:40 a.m. ONLY

**Conference sign-up sheets will be posted in the FRONT OFFICE on Wednesday, May 1.**

We realize that parents sign up for conference times around their work and family schedules and need to return at specific times. We will try to stay on schedule that day and request that all parents help us by arriving **5 minutes prior** to their scheduled conference as well as respecting the next person’s conference time. Parents who do not arrive on time will have a shortened conference session or may miss their conference. On conference day, we ask that you check in at the front desk *before* going to your child’s classroom, so as not to disturb a conference in progress. A copy of your child’s progress report will be in their Friday folders on Friday, May 10. By taking the time to review the progress report before your conference you can maximize your conference time with your child’s teacher.

We encourage ALL parents to participate in parent conferences, as it is the perfect time to sit with the teacher and focus on YOUR CHILD without interruption. Regretfully, with June program preparations upon us, teachers will be unable to provide additional times to review your child’s progress report following the formal conference date.



## **PARENT QUESTIONNAIRES FOR ACCREDITATION**

As parents, we know that you are proud to have your child at an NAEYC accredited program. A VERY important component of our accreditation relies on positive feedback from our parents.

Our parent questionnaire is given to us by NAEYC and when discussed with our parent advisory board we realize that the questions are not always clear in meaning or may address areas that parents may not be aware of as it does not apply to their child’s needs while in the program.

We have worked diligently to be sure that we meet each component, thus, if you cannot answer yes or would leave it blank because you do not know specifically how we meet it, PLEASE, take a moment to ask Ms. Lisa how it is met before you select an answer. If your experience is different than how it has been explained, then be sure to answer as you wish. This is important

feedback for us. It is also helpful for us if you include your name or comments which address your perspective.
