HEALTHY MORNING SNACK REMINDER

We want to remind parents that morning snack is a part of the day's nutritional component for each child and is NOT a "treat". We thus ask parents to be aware of sending healthy foods from the snack grid and suggestion list compiled by the school. These suggestions are whole foods, whole grains, low sugar. Serving sizes are also shown at the top of each food group. Please note that we cannot serve foods containing nuts and that "treats" that contain no nutrition may be sent home at the end of the day without having been served. (A healthy alternative will be served.)

EXTRA CLOTHES

As we finally "breeeze" into cooler weather please remember to check your child's extra clothes supplies. Each child should have at least TWO complete sets of clothing: underwear, socks, shirts and long pants. Younger children should have THREE sets. Extra clothes should be put in a Ziploc bag and all pieces of clothing should be labeled with your child's name. Please remember to bring a jacket for your child to wear as the weather cools in the afternoons. Due to limited space on the classroom coatracks, we ask each child to have only ONE jacket at a time. Thank you!!

HELP US SAVE PAPER AND TIME!

Do you need the monthly tuition receipts you have requested? We have many monthly receipts that are not picked up month after month. Please check with your school's director and confirm with them if you still need a monthly paper receipt.

Beginning December 1, 2019, we will remove families from the monthly receipt list if you have not confirmed. We are more than happy to continue to provide receipts for the families who need and pick one up each month. We do ask you to continue requesting a monthly receipt and to save them in a safe place, if you need receipts for tax purposes next year, as we are not able to generate a "year-end" receipt. Projects made by your little ones will make wonderful holiday gifts... Don't miss out- sign up by completing the form at the front desk. The painting date will be Thursday, December 6th.



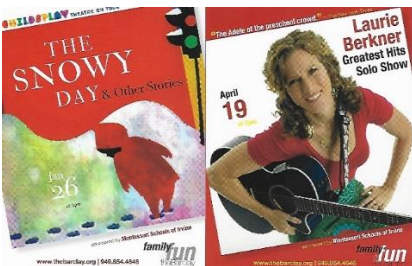
HOLIDAY SHARING

Fall Pumpkin Bake

- 1 medium pumpkin
- 1 red, 1 green and 1 yellow apple
- 1 ½ cups frozen cranberries
- 1 cup raisins
- 1 teaspoon cinnamon
- 2 Tablespoons brown sugar
- 3 Tablespoons white sugar, to taste



1. Scoop out insides of pumpkin and throw away (save the seeds for roasting!)
2. Slice apples into bite size pieces.
3. Mix together all ingredients. Put mixture into pumpkin shell.
4. Bake in 350-degree oven for 3-4 hours, until mixture is soft.
5. Serve with vanilla ice cream.
